FUNDRAISING FOR THE COMING TERM

At present, the usual fund raising activities will either have to be cancelled or carried out in a different form but we have many ideas for events which can take place virtually or within appropriate guidelines.

- 1) Lotto squares. To run for 4 weeks initially. Each class can buy numbered squares for £1 each per week. A winning number for each class will be drawn weekly and the winner will take half of their classes takings.
- 2) **Spot the random object**. We will be asking every shop in Newton Abbot to participate in a game whereby they place an unusual object in their shop window. - 4) Katy Steele suggested an ongoing book sale in school. Mrs Edwards to see if this is viable.

- 5) **Christmas cards.** Children designing their own Christmas cards to be purchased by their families. Miss Massey and Kelly Wagstaff to get some quotes for printing these.
- 6) **Tea towels.** Mrs Webber suggested that we have class tea towels printed with each child doing a self portrait to be added to their class tea towels.
- 7) Virtual cupcake/Gingerbread man competition. Mrs Webber suggested that we hold a virtual baking competition whereby the children send in photo's of their creations to be judged and win a prize.
- 8) **Mufti days.** We hope to hold two mufti days, one of which to be possibly incorporated into individual class disco's.
- 9) **Class Decs.** We are hoping to be able to make decorations with the children for parents to purchase.

To provide KS1 children with a socially distanced visit to Santa in the outdoor classroom with something else suitably appropriate for KS2 children.

To provide the whole school with an event to replace our usual pantomime/ theatre visit.

To try and allow the children to have an end of term disco in their classrooms.
