Dear Parents

As we enter this next national lockdown we hope that you and your families remain safe and well. This is a challenging time for all of us and we are here to support our community and to ensure that our children have a safe, happy and welcoming place to learn.

Since we wrote to you earlier in the week the government has updated the guidance for schools and, as promised, we want to let you know what is happening. All precautions are being taken and the safety and wellbeing of your child and our staff comes first.

Reassuringly, the measures that were implemented in September remain the same. In primary schools the government has stated that: **More evidence has emerged that shows there is a very low risk of children becoming very unwell from coronavirus (COVID-19), even for children with existing health conditions.**

Our current measures such as bubbles, social distancing of staff and parents, good hygiene and ventilation remain. Your child will not experience any changes in this respect.

In secondary schools staff have been advised to wear masks when they are outside of their bubbles and moving around schools. We have taken the decision to also apply this in school. Your child's teachers will not be wearing a face covering when teaching your child and in their bubble or outside but adults will wear face coverings when it is necessary for them to move around the school.

**Children are not required to wear face coverings.**

I am sure that you are reassured by the fact that there are no significant changes because the measures already in place are robust and working.

We want to thank you once again for continuing to socially distance at drop off and pick up times, wearing a face covering and supporting this national lockdown outside of school in order to keep our community safe.

We hope that you and your families continue to stay safe and well during this period.
