Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for taking the time to fill out our form last night for key worker provision. We now have a list of children to be able to plan staffing.

### Do I need a school place?

Please remember that the advice is to **stay at home** and only use schools when **absolutely essential**. Attendance for those in school is flexible and only needs to be used to enable critical workers to fill front line jobs **on the days that are necessary** and to support vulnerable children. Please let us know if you do not need all five days.

**If you do not need to put your child in school, then the advice is please don't and this way we can help to reduce the National risk by not having a high volume of children in school.**

### What happens in school?

The expectations are very different to the last lockdown. Schools are now required to supply a full day's remote learning for all children whether at home or in school. This means that the children in school will be in a class with either a member of our support staff (this will be on rota and will not necessarily be the same adult each day) and will be facilitated to complete the remote learning on Google Classroom in the same way that those at home will be with their parents. The focus is on equity of provision for all.

### School Lunches

If your child is in school and requires a school lunch, please can you re order this on School Money, as all previous orders have been cleared.

### Coming to School

Please do not turn up to school, if you did not request a school place through the form, because we have only planned staffing to meet the numbers of children and we now have very limited capacity within the limits of our school risk assessment.

Thank you for helping to keep us all safe and our numbers in school as low as possible so that we can protect our staff, pupils and the local community as much as possible.

We hope you were able to access the remote learning set by your child's class teacher on Google Classroom (or Tapestry for our Reception children). We know there will be teething problems with some of the systems so do please keep in touch. If you are struggling with accessing any of the remote learning please talk to your class teacher and they will ensure you have remote learning that you can access.

Thank you for your patience as these systems are set up and thank you for supporting your children at home, we know this can be a challenging time for many.
