Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to begin by saying a huge thank you to you all for everything that you have done this week and for the kind messages that we've been receiving, it certainly has been a busy time since we all heard the announcement at the 8pm briefing on Monday! The teachers here have had to help me with Google Classroom and teach me how to set up the live assemblies so we are all learning together! Our Reception children are accessing some fun activities from their teachers on Tapestry and it's been brilliant to see so many parents using this platform.

- If children would like to complete their learning on paper, this can be shared with the teacher by taking a photo and uploading it to the Google Classroom Stream.
- Good news - you are able to access Google Classroom through an Xbox or Playstation - see info below. Please note that you cannot 'turn in' the work back to the teacher using this, instead, children should note down their answers / work, take a photo and add it to the stream on Google Classroom. If you need a jotter book for this, please let us know. We have sent an additional letter with these further instructions on how to access this.



1. Turn on PS4
2. Use your controller to scroll to the far right of the bar with games to *Library*
3. Select *Library* application
4. Within the library use the search bar to type in *Internet*
5. Select the *Internet Browser* app
6. Start Internet Browser and press the triangle button on the controller to search
7. Once on the internet, type in the search box *Google Classroom* and select the first link that comes up:  
Classroom: manage teaching and learning Google for Education - link below'

8. Select *Go to Classroom*. Then log in using student email and password.

2. Select *My Games and Apps*
3. Scroll down to Apps
4. Go to *Microsoft Edge* application
5. Type in a search for Google Classroom
6. Select *Go to Classroom*
7. You will need to log in using your student email address and password.

### Maintaining Contact

In addition to remote education, we will be hosting some live sessions using Google Meet beginning next week. **These will not be live lessons.** These sessions will give the children a chance to interact with their teacher and each other. A timetable and information regarding how this will work will be communicated in class newsletters. These sessions will be staggered as we

know some children may need to share a digital device with their siblings and therefore cannot all be on at once.

When accessing these sessions please ensure the following:

- That your child will be working in a secure and appropriate environment and consider what can be seen on screen e.g. appropriate backgrounds.
- That all people attending the session are appropriately dressed.
- Please mute your sound to ensure there is no background noise or interference during the session. We will invite the children to unmute or use the chat at times during the session.
