Dear Parents and Carers,

Please be advised that over the weekend we have been notified of positive covid cases, confirmed by PCR tests, in both of the classes that are currently isolating. These are in addition to the confirmed cases we began the isolation period for.

Because the children have not been in school since Tuesday there are no additional steps to take and, if they are well, the children in Bradley and Templar will be able to return to school on Friday at the end of the 10 day period of self-isolation; returning to their usual activities outside of school and can attend school for the final day. Please refer to the letter sent at the beginning of the isolation period for further clarification.

The remaining classes in school, Forde and Courtenay, remain unaffected at this time and should attend school as normal.

I will communicate any further updates as soon as I have them.
