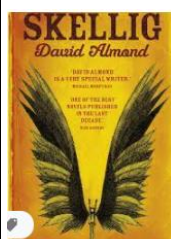
**Star of the week:

Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the second half of the Autumn term and I hope that you all managed to get some rest. This term, we have a few new exciting books and topics that we will be learning about.

In PE, we will be learning some Gymnastic skills and we will be looking at graceful movements that real gymnasts learn to do. Geography will focus on map skills and the children will learn about the 'invisible lines of the world' such as the equator. Art will focus on colour and space, while RHE will be on families and respect. We have just completed our place value topic in Maths and will soon also be finishing Addition and Subtraction in a couple of weeks.
