



## Yr5&6 TEMPLAR CLASS SPRING TERM 2022

### LITERACY

This term, Templar class will be building on to their *Writing to Inform* skills and our focus will be on letter writing to start with. We will create our own letters by using ambitious vocabulary that is now part of our daily routine. We are also recording all the marvellous vocabulary that we find in our reading and exploration of similar texts. Please make sure that children are reading at least four times at home in order to continue to enhance their vocabulary. As a vehicle for writing, we will also be looking at ideas from our class book *Street Child* by Berlie Doherty.

### MATHS

To help us to develop a growth mindset, this term we will be focusing on multiplication and division in both year groups. We will continue to develop our times table skills by practising them every day. This will continue to encourage the children to quicken their pace in maths lessons when solving problems. We will begin to solve more multi-step problems in our lessons to familiarise ourselves with the process.

### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Creation and Science: conflict or complimentary? This is the question that we will be looking at this time. The children will explore various ideas about the origins of the Earth and they will also discuss their own views. As a class, we will compare and contrast these ideas and look at the effect on the world. We will also come up with our own questions and put them in categories to see whether they can be best answered by Religion or Science.

### DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY

This term we will be exploring cereal bars and how their appearance reflect the customer. We will plan and create our own products using paper cereals and some healthy decorations.

### HISTORY

Our focus is on the Victorians and the influence they had on the life that we live today. Our learning will be inquiry based and the children will use various questions to find out about a part of British history.

### PHYSICAL EDUCATION

In PE, we will be focusing on Dance, which will develop the children's co-ordination skills, from movement to keeping up with the beat of the songs. Children will create some dances in groups.

### Relationships and Health Education

As part of our ongoing RHE learning, we will be looking at *Celebrating differences*. As we move forward, we will also be exploring 'Families' as it is part of the national curriculum. There will be more information that we will provide so that you are aware of the content that we teach our pupils.
