EVERYONE is a PE superstar for a wonderful dance lesson!

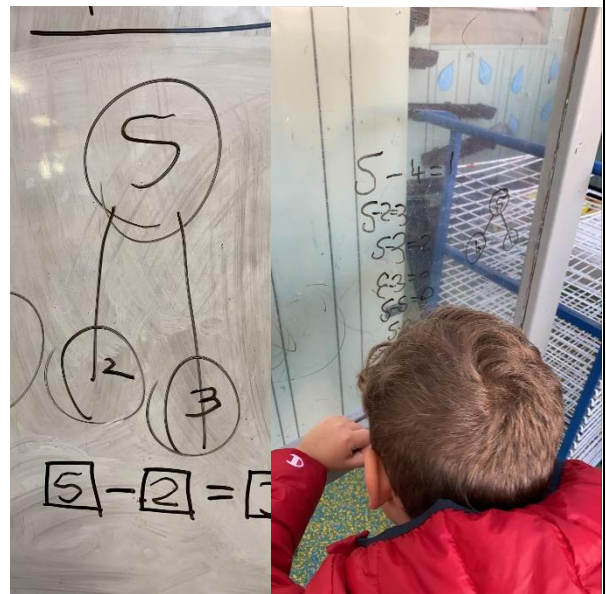
Dear Parents,
