- Make sure that your file is organised into sections. Try to talk through each section at a time with the assessor- don't confuse them by muddling your evidence
- The assessors really want you to be successful. They will not try to trick you!
- You may take a phone, laptop or tablet into your assessment to show photos or films
- Smile when you meet your assessor. Shake hands and introduce yourself
- Learn and use your assessor's name
- This is your chance to shine! Be honest and show off all you have done!
- Try to relax and enjoy yourself!
- Thank them at the end.
