Forest School at All Saints Marsh

Find Your Wild <u>Home - Find Your Wild</u> is delighted to be bringing forest school to All Saints Marsh. They cannot wait to work with our children as they gain new skills and experiences outdoors. As a small, urban school, they will be adapting their activities to the space and needs of the children. Some of the activities your child(ren) will be involved in include simple bushcraft skills such as learning to light a fire safely, shelter building, and camp cooking, as well as nature crafts and learning about the environment and living things. They hope to plant a grow some food too. Through these, they will build their confidence and resilience, learn to work as a team, and solve problems.

The children will go outdoors come rain or shine, so during this time of year the children will need:

- warm clothes for outdoor play (we suggest that the children wear their PE kits with long jogging bottoms.
- waterproof coats with a hood (and trousers if possible)
- warm hats and gloves
- trainers or wellies (if wet weather worn with warm socks) and
- a change of clothes (if wet weather)

The sessions will run every Friday – starting on Friday 25^{th} March. Forde Class will participate from 9.15 - 11.15 am with Bradley Class in the afternoon from 1 - 3 pm.

They may come home muddy but always, we hope, with a smile of their faces!
