Red Nose Day - Friday 18th March 2022.

We are excited to be able to support Red Nose Day this year. The donations received helps projects and organisations to make a real difference to the lives of millions of people across the UK and around the world.



Poverty isn't simple, and it's not always easy to see. It's behind so many of the issues that Comic Relief work to tackle. In each of these areas, the COVID-19 pandemic has made people's lives even harder, so our support is as important as ever.

We are planning a fun and active day in school and invite the children to wear something red into school or wear a crazy hair style (or do both!). It will be a non-school uniform day – so if you don't have something red please do not worry.

We would also like to hold a cake sale. So if there are any budding bakers out there who would be happy to donate or bake some cakes for us to sell from 2.45pm on the main playground that would be much appreciated. KS1 please pop round to the main entrance to purchase your cakes. Please pass your cake donations onto your Class Teacher in the morning.

Each class will also be taking part in ½ hour activity – maybe yoga, dancing, running or something else! With every school in our Trust taking part, the pupils will be contributing to a 24 hour activity as a collective.
