LITERACY

Forde class will continue on their Read Write Inc. journey throughout the Summer Term. Oral blending plays a significant part in early reading and we will explore this skill through lots of fun games and activities. We will also be using our fingers to help us to 'pinch to blend' the sounds, so that we can read and write words, captions and sentences. In addition to this we will be enjoying listening to a collection of traditional tales and poems.

MATHS

To help us to develop our marvellous mathematical brains, this term we will be focusing on numbers from 11-20 and then beyond 20. We will continue to develop our subitising skills through Number Sense Maths as we learn to look at a small number of objects and instantly recognise how many there are without needing to count them. We will continue to explore pattern and spatial reasoning through children's story books and we will explore measurement in relation to length, height, weight, volume and time.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

We will be exploring the Christian faith by learning about the Gospel. We will be using our school values to explore Christianity further, particularly looking at spreading 'good news' through charity work. KS1 will be exploring all aspects of plants over the Summer Term which will be supported in our Forest School learning.

EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

This term we will be exploring different media and materials to help us develop our imaginative and creative artistic skills. In DT, we will be exploring wheels and axles and having the opportunity to create our own vehicles using junk modelling. We will continue our music lessons using Charanga whilst developing our knowledge of pitch and finding the pulse of different styles of music.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

We will be broadening our vocabulary by learning lots of new words and their meanings within science, history and geography. We will continue to read lots of stories with a focus on James and the Giant Peach by Roald Dahl..

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

In PE, we will be exploring different activities through athletics with Mr Kirk at Spires College. We will be practising hard for our upcoming sports day!
