

KS1 SPRING TERM 2022

RWInc

KS1 will be continuing on their RWInc journey this term and they will be exploring new vocabulary within a range of books. KS1 will learning how to read more challenging texts to enhance their grammar and writing skills. KS1 will be developing their reading comprehension skills this term, learning how to retrieve key information from what they have read. Finally, this term KS1 will be learning to how to write different sentence types for different purposes.

Maths

This term KS1 will be continuing to develop their mental arithmetic and number fluency through number sense at the start of every maths session. This term KS1 will be consolidating their understanding on fractions. The children will be learning how to recognise and find the fractions $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ of a shape and an amount. The children will be recognising and learning equalivent fractions. Moving into the summer term, the children will be exploring, recognising and finding the properties of common 2D and 3D shapes.

RE

We will be exploring the Christian faith. The children will be understanding what Christians believe God is like. Furthermore, the children will be learning about what good news means to the Christian faith and how God brings good news to everyone.

SCIENCE

KS1 will be exploring plants in our local environment. The children will be learning about different parts of a plant, what plants need to survive. We will then be investigating these limiting factors through working scientific experiments.

HISTORY

As Historians, KS1 will be exploring significant people focusing on Florence Knightengale They will look at the impact she had.

PE

In PE, KS1 will be exploring movement through athletics.
