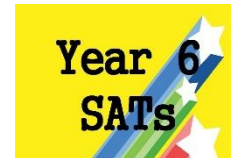
The Year 6 pupils

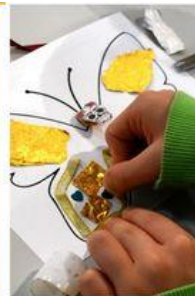
