RWInc

KS1 will be continuing on their RWInc journey this term and they will be exploring new vocabulary within a range of books. KS1 will learning how to read more challenging texts to enhance their grammar and writing skills. KS1 will be developing their reading comprehension skills this term, learning how to retrieve key information from what they have read. Finally, this term KS1 will be learning to how to write different sentence types for different purposes.

Maths

This term, we will consolidate the children's understanding of place value by comparing, ordering, and sequencing numbers, using manipulatives to help understand how these numbers can be split up into tens and ones. The children will independently apply their understanding of the greater than, less than and equal to symbols ($=$, $<$, $>$). They will then explore addition and subtraction using number bond diagrams, as well as the standard column method.

RE

In RE, we are going to be learning about what it means to belong to a faith community, with a particular focus on Christianity.

SCIENCE

Our topic in science this term will be Animal Safari. Through this unit the children will get the opportunity to find out about different types of animals and be able to group them into the different animal classifications.

HISTORY

As historians, we are going to be learning about Sir Francis Drake. The children will find out about life in the 1500s and the importance of his voyages. They will look at transport during the time in which he was exploring the world!

PE

This term, PE will be taught by Mr S. He will be focusing on building the children's gross motor skills through well thought out team games.
