Dear Parents and carers,

It has been a very exciting week – with an awful lot going on! Can I start by saying how proud we all were of the children on Tuesday when we had our special visitors in. All the children were confident, cheerful and welcoming to our guests and spoke eloquently about their learning.

The church service was lovely on Wednesday and it was so nice to see lots of parents attending. The children worked hard on their singing prior to the service and were excited to walk over to the church in their bonnets (despite the blustery weather!).

Year 1 and Year 2 children were very excited to make boats in Science this week and test whether they were 'sea-worthy'! We evaluated our designs and worked scientifically to see whether there were changes we

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would make next time. This brings our topic of 'Changing Materials' to a close and we will be looking at Plants in the Summer term.

In Maths this week Year 1 and Year 2 have been looking at measuring mass. They have measured the mass of classroom objects using balance scales, and Year 2 children have been beginning to look at using grams as a unit of measurement.

Finally, this week we say goodbye to our student teacher Miss Peach. Miss Peach has worked mainly with Reception children and I am sure she will be hugely missed by those children in particular. We also say goodbye to Mrs Pike – although she will be returning to work with older children in the summer term. Thank you to both of you for all your hard work!
