example, 'the clouds burst into tears.' The vocabulary has to be chosen really carefully with this skill but here are some great examples:

During Science, Year 5 and Year 6 considered how the shape of an object impacts the amount of water resistance. We learned that smooth, streamlined shapes are more successful at floating in water. Size actually has very little to do with it if you get the shape right, which was a surprise to some of us.

Lastly, a final word to all Year 6 parents and children: please spend this weekend sleeping, relaxing and having a great time together. There is no set home learning: the children know what particular areas they need to work on if they wish to do any extra revision. (BBC Bitesize website is always a good starting point.)


