Templar Year 4 and Year 5 continue to impress us with their flexibility and willingness to learn, despite the changes to their timetable. The Year 6s, Miss Blakesley and I are very lucky to have such a supportive class.

Wider curriculum lessons have continued in the afternoons this week. In Science, we explored water resistance in more detail. Last week, in an experiment about making playdough shapes that float or sink, we realised that surface area effected water resistance. More surface area = more water resistance = more likely to float. We put this theory to the test this week by attempting to make playdough boats. Some worked – and some really didn't! Our learning has developed because we now know that shape and surface area are equally as important to generate water resistance and make an object float.

In RHE, we discussed mental health. We covered lots of Top Tips to help keep a good mental health by watching videos and sharing our own ideas. Some suggestions are:

- Be kind.
- By reducing screen time, eating healthily and making good choices about drinks, help yourself get a good night's sleep.
- Listen to music that you like.

Our most important learning from this lesson was that it is OK not to be OK and that it's really important to talk about mental health.
