Good Deed Day was a resounding success in Forde class on Thursday, with children showing our school value of Compassion throughout the day by making friendship bands, writing cards to loved ones and being helpful around the classroom. Thank you to all children for being so thoughtful and kind to one another!

In Maths this week, Year 1 children have been learning how to tell the time to the hour and to the half hour. Year 2 children have continued their work on Money and using their reasoning skills to solve money problems. Reception children have been using strategies to count with accuracy and partition numbers to ten.

We finished our History topic this week by comparing the lives of Emily Davison and Rosa Parks and evaluating what changes came about due to their actions. The children made links between their learning on Suffragettes and the Civil Rights movement to round up their learning this term.

In Science this week we have continued our work on Plants by testing whether plants can grow in different conditions. We planted cress seeds in sand, soil, stones, on tissue and cotton wool. We will watch to see which seeds grow successfully!

In Art we finished our learning on Kandinsky by making our own versions of Kandinsky's Circles. We have been studying colour, brush strokes and the meaning of 'abstract' Art over this half term and our final pieces look fantastic!

The week beginning 10th June is the Phonics Screening Check week and we will be administering the test to all Year 1 children and some Year 2 children throughout the week. Thank you to all parents that were able to attend the meeting on Thursday, if you have any questions about the Phonics screening please come and ask me or send me a message via Seesaw. I am sending home QR codes for all children to access Phonics videos over the half term holiday – any practise you can do over the next two weeks would be so valuable and will keep up momentum. The children have worked so hard over the school year on their Phonics, and I am proud of them all for making such good progress.

Have a fantastic two weeks off – the children have earned a break and I look forward to welcoming them all back for the final half-term! It seems to have flown!
