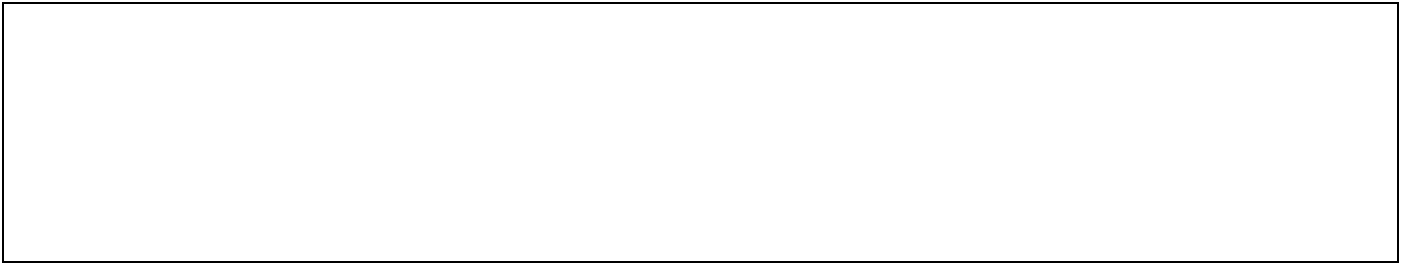
OFFICE NEWS
