At the back of each child's home learning book, you will find a print out of the updated Recommended Reads to suit their year group. These are taken from the Reader Teacher website, which is not just for teachers! It's a fantastic resource for finding contemporary authors that are writing brand new, hot-off-the-press books and for broadening knowledge of different authors. I regularly use Book Match: if you like a certain popular author,

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Outdoors. Their bravery and resilience was also very impressive in such new environments.

Book Match will give you a list of authors who write in similar styles. For part of home learning this week, each child needs to use their local library or online to research one of the Recommended Reads. (If you're registered as a member - which is free and very simple to do at the library - you could even take the book out! If it's not in stock in your local library, it can be ordered in for you from other Devon libraries free of charge.) Each child will then verbally present their findings to a partner. Some helpful research sentence stems could be:

- I chose to research this particular book because...
- The blurb makes it sound like it will be...
- I have read books by a similar author so I thought...

Look closely at all the books to spot how many we have already read in class!
