At the start of each writing unit, the children complete an Elicitation task which is usually a piece of writing that is similar to what is coming ahead in the unit. This is so that teachers can see what children already know and what teaching they need more of. Templar needed to liven up their writing: we have used the language of '2D writing' versus '3D writing.' The last few lessons have therefore been spent on vocabulary generation and techniques such as pairing verbs and adverbs together to bring the writing to life.
	Our History topic is about how the Industrial Revolution impacted society. We began with a broad overview of what life was like before the Industrial Revolution, so that we can then see impact after it. We are now narrowing our study to look specifically at the impact on transport which leads into our trip to Newton Abbot Museum on Monday 7 th October where we will explore this question – 'What was the impact of the railway on Newton Abbot?'
