Dear Parents and Carers.

The children of Courtenay Class have enjoyed another excellent and exciting week, in which they have gained new knowledge and skills.

In Science, we conducted an experiment which involved testing different rocks for hardness; durability; how they react with water; and how they react to a mild acid (vinegar). The children were particularly excited when the chalk samples started to fizz as parts of the previously-solid rocks became gas after white wine vinegar was poured onto it!

In History, we have been learning about life in Anglo-Saxon Britain, and how the five kingdoms of Wessex, Mercia, Kent, Northumbria and East Anglia were ruled by kings who oversaw societies which also involved thanes and churls. The children particularly enjoyed re-enacting some
