We are currently writing the independent outcome for our English unit: it is a space-themed story, based on the book 'Lights on Cotton Rock.' One of the main learning points in this unit has been to show the children that not all stories need to follow the traditional structure of beginning (build-up), middle (event) and end (resolution). Instead, you could start with an event! The children planned the piece earlier in the week, starting with an event and then independently chose the structure of their narrative from then on. Please do ask them about the authorial choices they made and why.

- The theme of this book is ______. What other books have we read with a similar theme?
