Red Nose Day – Friday 21st March 2025.

We are excited to be able to support Red Nose Day this year. The donations received helps projects and organisations to make a real difference to the lives of millions of people across the UK and around the world.



Poverty isn't simple, and it's not always easy to see. It's behind so many of the issues that Comic Relief work to tackle. In each of these areas, the COVID-19 pandemic and the financial crisis has made people's lives even harder, so our support is as important as ever.

We will be spending time in school thinking about why we are raising money and invite the children to wear something red into school. Please do worry if you do not have a full red outfit, it will be a non-school uniform day with something 'red' where possible e.g. red socks, hairband, jumper etc.

- MORE THAN 29,000 people who have experienced or are at risk of domestic abuse to access safe accommodation and specialist services and
- MORE THAN 46,000 children and young people in the UK, and more than 8.1 million internationally.
