Reading: Record a new read – something that you would not normally read (new genre or new author). See separate sheet.

Wow, what a busy final week! The pace has not slowed so well done to the children – and the school grown-ups! – for keeping up! This week, we produced our beautiful books in English, ready to share with parents. We have finished our whole class reading book (My Friend the Octopus) and we have rehearsed and enjoyed our Easter Service.

Our class book – 'My Friend the Octopus' by Lindsay Galvin – is an historical story, set in England in 1893. It has therefore been challenging for the children to imagine this world because so much is different to today: for example, how women were treated and what science understood about animals and animal welfare. It is really important to occasionally read books that are not typical of your normal 'Reading diet,' because it encourages you to transfer skills from more familiar books to new contexts. It helps you learn about people, places and events that you would not normally have

considered learning about and it opens up your imagination to a whole new way of writing.

Over the holiday, please therefore encourage your children to read something different, that they would not normally try. This could be a different genre – for example, if they always choose fictional stories, they could read a non-fiction text – or a different author. 

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

With the recent change in Government in the UK, we have been informed that it is possible that there may be a change with new free school meal applications.

Currently if you apply for Free School Meals and you are successful your child is guaranteed to have free school meals until they leave Primary School at the end of Year 6. We have been informed that after 1st April 2025 this may change and your children would be subject to ongoing checks and if your circumstances change you may no longer be eligible and free school meals would stop. Therefore, can we please encourage any family who thinks they may be entitled to free school meals

(even if your child is in Reception or Key Stage 1 and therefore does not currently pay for their meals), to please apply as soon as possible and before the end of March 2025. If you are successful this will guarantee your child remains eligible until the end of Primary School.

You can make the application online at the Devon Citizen Portal Free school meals - Support for schools and settings Alternatively, please email the school at allsaints@lapsw.org and a paper form can be sent home which can be returned to the office who will then submit this for you. Please do remember though, this needs to be before the end of March 2025 to ensure you receive this on an ongoing basis. If your child is already eligible then you do not need to take any action and your child will remain eligible until the end of Year 6.


COMMUNITY NEWS
